

Prepare for Success with the Quality Payment Program

On October 14, 2016, the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) issued its final rule of the Quality Payment Program (QPP) that is part of the Medicare Access and CHIP Reauthorization Act of 2015 (MACRA). The QPP replaces Meaningful Use and improves Medicare by providing new tools and resources that help you focus on care quality and the one thing that matters most — making patients healthier. If you participate in Medicare, the QPP is for you!

Quality Payment Program Timeline

CMS began the first performance period of the QPP on January 1, 2017 and it ends on December 31, 2017. During 2017, record quality data and how you used technology to support your practice, and submit the information to CMS.

Submit all your quality data by March 31, 2018 to potentially earn a positive payment adjustment.



Choosing your Participation Method

If you provide Medicare services, the question is not if you will participate, but how. Your practice will choose when you begin data submission in 2017 and if your practice will participate in MIPS or as an APM. Unsure as to how you should participate?
